Meek Trucking Company requests that its certificated operating authority as a highway common carrier be revoked.

The certificate was granted by Decision No. 62131, dated June 13, 1961, as amended by Decision No. 64092, dated August 7, 1962, by Decision No. 70238, dated January 18, 1966 and by Decision No. 72105, dated February 28, 1967, and authorizes the transportation of rice, barley, wheat and animal and poultry feed, in bulk, between points in northern California.

It is alleged that applicant's service can better be performed pursuant to its radial highway common carrier permit.

After consideration the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity no longer require applicant's service as a highway common carrier. A public hearing is not necessary.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The operating authority heretofore granted to Meek Trucking Company by Decision No. 62131, dated June 13, 1961, and as amended by Decision No. 64092, dated August 7, 1962, by Decision No. 70238, dated January 18, 1966, and by Decision No. 72105 dated February 28, 1967, is hereby revoked.

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2. The tariffs presently on file with this Commission in the name of Meck Trucking Company are hereby cancelled.
