## SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 72016, dated February 15, 1967, in Application No. 48957, Fort Terminal Transport, Inc., acquired certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier granted by Decision No. 22927, dated October 2, 1930, in Application No. 16709.

port Terminal Transport, Inc., filed with this Commission a certified copy of certificate of amendment of articles of incorporation, which have been filed with the Secretary of State, changing the corporate name to G.R.M. Inc.

Accordingly, the certificate will be amended to show the new corporate name. The carrier will also be ordered to amend its tariffs pursuant to General Order No. 80-A. A public hearing is not necessary.

## IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Decision No. 72016, dated February 15, 1967, in Application No. 48957, is amended by substituting "G.R.M. Inc." in place and stead of "Port Terminal Transport, Inc.".

- 2. Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, G.R.M. Inc. shall amend its tariffs on file with this Commission as required by Rule 6.4 of General Order No. 80-A.
- 3. G.R.M. Inc. shall comply with the requirements of the Commission's General Order No. 84-Series for the transportation of collect on delivery shipments. If G.R.M. Inc. elects not to transport collect on delivery shipments, it shall make the appropriate tariff filings as required by the General Order.
- 4. Except as amended herein, Decision No. 72016 shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
