ORDER PROVIDING FOR SERVICE BY MAIL

By Decision No. 76047, dated August 19, 1969, in Case No. 8863, the Commission ordered the defendant to cease and desist from operations as a passenger stage corporation. Said decision provided that defendant be personally served with a copy of the decision and that the decision would become effective twenty days after personal service.

Numerous attempts have been made to accomplish personal service without success. It appears that personal service cannot be accomplished and that Decision No. 76047 should be modified to provide for service by mail.

IT IS ORDERED that the last paragraph of Decision No. 76047 is hereby deleted and the following paragraph substituted therefor:

"The Secretary of the Commission is directed to cause service of this order to be made upon the defendant by mailing same to defendant at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records. The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date of mailing."

In all other respects Decision No. 76047 shall remain in full force and effect.
