SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 76204, entered today in Application No. 51335 and Case No. 5432 (Petition for Modification No. 553), et al., the Commission authorized National Motor Freight Traffic Association, Inc., Agent, to revise certain ratings and rules in National Motor Freight Classification A-10 and adopted such ratings and rules to govern various Commission minimum rate tariffs. The Commission concluded that Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 1-B and 2 should be amended to reflect changes in item number references to commodity descriptions in the Governing Classification and that the necessary amendments in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 1-B should be made by separate order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 1-B (Appendix B of Decision No. 65834, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective October 20, 1969, Fifth Revised Page 33-A and Original Page 33-AA attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than October 20, 1969, on not less than two days' notice to the Commission and to the public and such tariff publications shall be made effective not later than December 19, 1969.

3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the amendments authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the amendments published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

4. In all other respects Decision No. 65834, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be October 18, 1969.
