ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 75355 dated February 25, 1969, the Commission ordered the State of California Department of Public Works and the Santa Maria Valley Railroad Company to improve the Broadway Crossing, No. 38B-6.0, and its protection in the City of Santa Maria by September 17, 1969.

The railroad has requested an extension of time for the completion of work until such time as the Department constructs median islands to accommodate the crossing protection standards.

The construction of the median islands has been delayed due to the Department's request for rehearing in the matter and its Petition for Writ of Review with the California Supreme Court (SF No. 22665) which was denied on July 16, 1969.

IT IS ORDERED that the completion date for the improvements and installation of crossing protection at Crossing No. 38B-6.0 is extended to January 17, 1970.

In all other respects, Decision No. 75355 is reaffirmed and is in full force and effect.
