## SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 75570 the Commission granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to Norman W. Richardson and Janet M. Richardson authorizing them to operate as a passenger stage corporation. (Sight-seeing in and around Santa Cruz May 1 to September 30.)

This service was to be inaugurated in 1969.

By letter dated August 6, 1969, applicants request an extension of time until May 1, 1972, in which to provide the service. Lack of interest in the proposed sight-seeing service is cited as the reason for the request.

In view of the monopolistic character of the rights granted by Decision No. 75570, the Commission finds that it would not be in the public interest to extend the time for exercising of the rights granted.

The request for an extension will be denied.

IT IS ORDERED that operating authority granted by Decision No. 75570 is canceled.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
