ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

The certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Matthew J. Desmond, doing business as Desmond Mail Service (Desmond), has been under voluntary suspension since July 10, 1967.

In investigating the status of this carrier, the Commission staff found that Desmond is not performing any service as a highway common carrier. Furthermore, Desmond has not maintained his tariffs to conform with the Commission's outstanding minimum rate orders and has not filed his quarterly and annual reports with this Commission.

Matthew J. Desmond, having failed to have on file the required tariffs and having failed to file his quarterly and annual reports, the Commission finds that such failure constitutes good cause for revocation of the certificate.

IT IS ORDERED that:

 The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier granted to Matthew J. Desmond, an individual, doing business as Desmond Mail Service, by Decision No. 55243 dated July 9, 1957, in Application No. 35968 is hereby revoked.

2. Local Mail Delivery Tariff No. 1, Cal.P.U.C. No. 1 of Matthew J. Desmond, doing business as Desmond Mail Service, is hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Matthew J. Desmond or to mail a certified copy thereof to him at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Matthew J. Desmond or after the above mailing to him.
