ORDER

The City of Woodlake is hereby authorized to construct Acacia Street at grade across tracks of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company in the City of Woodlake, Tulare County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 2M-32.8-C.

Width of crossing shall be not less than forty feet and grades of approach not greater than six percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material.

Applicant shall bear entire expense of construction, also maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines.

This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
