FOURTH ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 71563, dated November 22, 1966 in Case No. 8102, the Commission ordered, among other things, the installation of automatic gates on or before June 30, 1969 at Sand Canyon Avenue (Crossing No. 2-182.9) on The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company in Orange County. The date for this installation was changed to September 30, 1969 by Decision No. 75911. By letter dated September 11, 1969 the railway alleges that due to the numerous other ordered installations and shortage of materials it is unable to comply with this deadline and requests an extension of time to January 31, 1970.

IT IS ORDERED that the completion date for the installation of the automatic gates at Sand Canyon Avenue (Crossing No. 2-182.9) is hereby extended to January 31, 1970.

In all other respects, Decision No. 71563, as amended,
shall remain in full force and effect.
