ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 72654 dated June 27, 1967, the Commission ordered a program of safety projects relating to a number of crossings located in the Cities of Oakland, San Leandro and Hayward and County of Alameda. On September 10, 1969, The Western Pacific Railroad Company filed a petition alleging that automatic gates have been installed at a number of crossings and that work on other crossings is still in process. It requests an extension of one year to complete the required projects.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the time within which to comply with the provisions of Decision No. 72654 as they relate to the following crossings is hereby extended to September 11, 1970:
