FOURTEENTH ORDER EXTENDING TIME

An extension of time has been requested by the City of La Verne within which to comply with Decision No. 67887 regarding the improvement of crossing protection at Carrion Road Crossing (No. 2-108.8) in the City of La Verne. Carrion Road is to be closed upon the concurrent opening of adjacent Wheeler Avenue Crossing (No. 2-108.5) as authorized in Decision No. 73684. Construction of Wheeler Avenue has been delayed due to current labor disputes and other project scheduling problems.

IT IS ORDERED that the time limit within which The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company shall complete the installation of improved crossing protection as required by Decision No. 67887 at Carrion Road Crossing (No. 2-108.8) is hereby extended to May 26, 1970.

In all other respects, the order in Decision No. 67887 as amended shall remain in full force and effect.
