SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision No. 74230, dated June 11, 1968, among other things, authorized the County of Orange to alter Main Street (Crossing No. BM-522.2) across a track of Southern Pacific Company's Tustin Branch partly in the City of Tustin, Orange County, with protection by three Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No.75-B).

The County of Orange by letter dated July 10, 1969, for reasons stated therein, requests a modification of the above decision to permit the alteration of the grade crossing without the installation of the ordered protection providing that such signals be installed prior to reestablishment of any railroad operations, which operations are now temporarily suspended due to a bridge being washed out. The county also requests a six months time extension from July 1, 1969 to exercise authority for undertaking the project.

The Southern Pacific Company has indicated that it is agreeable to the granting of these requests.

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 74230 is hereby modified to allow the alteration of Main Street (Crossing No. BM-522.2) without the crossing protection as ordered therein, providing that such protection be installed prior to restoration of rail operations over the crossing.

It is further ordered that the time limit within which applicant may exercise the authority granted in Decision No. 74230 is hereby extended to December 31, 1969.

In all other respects Decision No. 74230 shall remain in full force and effect.
