ORDER MODIFYING TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

On September 23, 1969, a temporary restraining order (Decision No. 76213) was issued by which Pacific Gas and Electric Company was ordered to refrain from further construction of its 230-kv transmission line between the Pittsburg generating station and El Sobrante Substation. By petition, filed September 26, 1969, Pacific Gas and Electric Company seeks modification of said order and sets forth in attachments thereto, for the first time in this proceeding, the route of the entire line and the scope and progress of work on the line. Based on this information, the Commission concludes that continued construction of the line from the Pittsburg power plant to and including Tower No. 83 of said line will not jeopardize the position of complainants herein and may now appropriately be authorized.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 76213, issued September 23, 1969, is hereby modified to the extent that construction may continue from defendant's Pittsburg power plant to, but not beyond, Tower No. 83 of its Pittsburg-El Sobrante 230-kv transmission line.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
