O P I N I O N

Mueller Truck Co. requests that its certificated authority as a highway common carrier be amended by excluding therefrom the right to transport shipments of liquid sodium hydroxide when originating at Vernon and the return of pallets to Vernon when used in such transportation.

It is alleged that applicant transports such shipments for only one shipper and wishes to continue said service pursuant to its permitted authority.

After consideration the Commission finds that the requested authority would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Appendix A of Decision No. 53261 is hereby amended by incorporating therein Third Revised Page 3 attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof in place of Second Revised Page 3.

2. Within sixty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public applicant shall amend its tariffs presently on file with the Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.

Applicant shall not transport any shipments of:

1. Used household goods and personal effects not packed in accordance with the crated property requirements set forth in Item No. 5 of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-B.
2. Automobiles, trucks and buses, viz.: new and used, finished or unfinished passenger automobiles, (including jeeps), ambulances, hearses and taxis; freight automobiles, automobile chassis, trucks, truck chassis, truck trailers, trucks and trailers combined, buses and bus chassis.
3. Livestock, viz.: bucks, bulls, calves, cattle, cows, dairy cattle, ewes, goats, hogs, horses, kids, lambs, oxen, pigs, sheep, sheep camp outfits, sows, steers, stags or swine.
- * 4. Commodities requiring the use of special refrigeration or temperature control in specially designed and constructed refrigerator equipment.
5. Liquids, compressed gases, commodities in semi-plastic form and commodities in suspension in liquids in bulk, in tank trucks, tank trailers, tank semitrailers or a combination of such highway vehicles.
6. Commodities when transported in bulk in dump trucks or in hopper-type trucks.
7. Commodities when transported in motor vehicles equipped for mechanical mixing in transit.
8. Logs.
9. Sodium (Soda) Hypochlorite Solution and liquid sodium hydroxide, originating at Vernon, and Pallets used in such transportation destined to Vernon.

* Does not apply for shipments between the San Diego Territory, on the one hand, and the City of Los Angeles, on the other hand, serving no intermediate points.
