SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In Decision No. 76142, dated September 10, 1969, City of Santa Ana was authorized by interim order to construct Santa Ana Boulevard across tracks of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company. Inadvertently the protection required therein for the crossing omitted the inclusion of automatic crossing gates.

To correct this, IT IS ORDERED that the fourth sentence of paragraph 1 on page 2 of Decision No. 76142 which now reads:

> "Protection shall be by four Standard No. 3 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B), two signals to be located on median islands."

is hereby modified to read as follows:

"Protection shall be by four Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) supplemented with automatic crossing gates, two signals to be located on median islands."

In all other respects Decision No. 76142 shall remain in full force and effect.
