FOURTH ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Applicant has requested an extension of time within which to comply with a condition of the order in Decision No. 68350, alleging that installation of crossing protection at the Deer Park Road grade crossing has not been completed due to the possible abandonment of a portion of the Calistoga branch line. Southern Pacific Company recently sought authority for this from the Interstate Commerce Commission, which matter has been subject of public hearings and is now submitted for decision.

IT IS ORDERED that the time limit within which applicant shall comply with the condition of said decision requiring the installation of two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) is hereby extended to June 30, 1970.

In all other respects Decision No. 68350 shall remain in full force and effect.
