I N T E R I M O R D E R

The State of California Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to alter the crossing of State Route No. 97 at grade with a track of Southern Pacific Company, being identified as Crossing No. CF-407.4, in the City of Dorris, Siskiyou County, as described and substantially as shown in the application. Width of crossing shall be not less than fifty-two feet and grades of approach not greater than one percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B), supplemented both by flashing light units on cantilever arms and by automatic gate arms.

Construction expense of the crossing and the installation of the automatic protection shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties or, if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. Maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines.

The parties are not in agreement as to sharing or apportionment of the maintenance costs of the grade crossing protection and have agreed that this cost be apportioned by further order of the Commission, pursuant to the provisions of Section 1202.2 of the Public Utilities Code.

The widened portion of crossing shall not be opened to public use until the protection ordered herein is installed and operative.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
