SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Order in Decision No. 75386, dated March 4, 1969, authorized the County of Sonoma to construct a new crossing at grade across a track of The Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company at Piner Road (Crossing No. 5-56.3) with protection by two Standard No. 3 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) augmented with automatic gate arms.

The County of Sonoma by letter dated September 4, 1969, for reasons stated therein, requests modification of the above order to permit authority for an increased crossing width of 64 feet, compared to 40 feet as previously proposed. Applicant also asks that crossing protection previously required be supplemented with flashing light units on cantilever arms.

The Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company, by letter dated September 11, 1969, has indicated that it is agreeable to the granting of the requested modification.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the second paragraph of the Order in Decision No. 75386, dated March 4, 1969, reading as follows:

"Width of crossing shall be not less than forty feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent. Construction

shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 3 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) augmented with automatic gate arms."

shall be modified to read as follows:

"Width of crossing shall be not less than 64 feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 3 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) augmented both by flashing light units on cantilever arms and automatic gate arms."

In all other respects Decision No. 75386 shall remain in full force and effect.
