SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Since 1960 Lads Furniture Freight, Inc. has been trans-
porting uncrated household, office and store furniture and fixtures
and appliances pursuant to certificated authority duly issued by the
Commission and corresponding registered rights issued by the Interstate
Commerce Commission. By Decision No. 75892 dated July 8, 1969, its
intrastate authority was amended so as to provide for the transporta-
tion of said commodities whether crated or uncrated. By its petition
filed August 12, 1969, applicant requested that Decision No. 75892 be
amended by incorporating therein a finding that public convenience and
necessity require applicant's service to the same extent on shipments
moving in interstate commerce. An appropriate notice was published in
the Federal Register on September 10, 1969. No protest has been
received.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The opinion portion of Decision No. 75892 dated July 8,
1969, is hereby amended by incorporating therein the following finding:

"Public convenience and necessity require
applicant's service for the transportation of
shipment of new household, office and store
furniture and fixtures, and new household, office
and store appliance moving in interstate commerce
between the points as set forth in Appendix A of
Decision No. 61029."

2. The time within which to comply with the provisions of Decision No. 75892 is hereby extended to February 1, 1970.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
