ORDER DISCONTINUING INVESTIGATION

The investigation in this matter was instituted to determine if respondent should be required to file tariffs covering scheduled air transportation of passengers between San Diego and Catalina Island, and Orange County and Catalina Island. Recent investigation discloses that respondent has discontinued all scheduled operations and is now providing charter plane service only.

Upon motion of the Commission staff for dismissal of this case we find that there is no need to continue this investigation and conclude that the case should be dismissed.

IT IS ORDERED that the Commission investigation in Case No. 8458 is discontinued and said case is dismissed.
