ORDER EXTENDING PERIOD OF SUSPENSION

By an order of suspension and investigation, issued July 8, 1969, certain tariff sheets of Hornitos Telephone Company, filed under Advice Letter No. 19, were suspended to and including November 10, 1969, pending public hearing and further order of the Commission. It appears that conclusion of the matter may not be accomplished by November 10, 1969.

Good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS ORDERED that the operation and effectiveness of the tariff sheets filed under respondent's Advice Letter No. 19 are hereby suspended, as provided by statute, for an additional period of six months to and including May 10, 1970, unless otherwise hereafter ordered.

The Secretary of the Commission is directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served forthwith upon the Hornitos Telephone Company and to send copies to The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company and the Continental Telephone Company of California (formerly Golden State Telephone Company).
