OPINION AND ORDER By Decision No. <u>76408</u>, entered today in Case No. 5435 (Order Setting Hearing Decision No. 74992 of November 26, 1968) et al., further disposition was made of the existing exception ratings and rules contained in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5, thereby reflecting the recent adoption of National Motor Freight Classification A-10 to otherwise govern said tariff. The decision also provided that Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5 should be amended by separate order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution. IT IS ORDERED that: Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5 (Appendix A to Decision No. 32504, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective January 3, 1970, the revised pages attached hereto and listed in Appendix A, also attached hereto, which pages and appendix by this reference are made a part hereof. 2. Common corriers subject to the Public Utilities Act. to the extent that they are subject also to Decision No. 32504, as amended, are hereby directed to establish in their tariffs the increases necessary to conform with the further adjustments ordered herein. -17. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the rates authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rates published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

8. In all other respects said Decision No. 32504, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
