SUPPLEMENTARY ORDER

It appearing that Edgar L. Kelley, Sr., the respondent herein, has failed to comply with any of the ordering paragraphs of Decision No. 74955, dated November 19, 1968, and it further appearing that respondent now holds no operating authority from this Commission,

IT IS ORDERED that no new permit shall be issued to respondent as an individual, nor to any partnership or company in which he has a financial interest, nor to any corporation in which said Kelley holds five or more percent of the stock or ownership thereof, unless and until respondent shall have complied with the requirements of Decision No. 74955 in this proceeding.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
