SECOND ORDER EXTENDING TIME

The City of Los Angeles has requested that The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company be granted an extension of time to July 1, 1970 to comply with Decisions No. 72251 and No. 75208, due to delays encountered by the city in constructing the necessary median islands to accommodate the ordered automatic crossing protection at the South Figueroa Street Crossing, No. 2-137.7.

IT IS ORDERED that the time within which to install automatic crossing protection at Crossing No. 2-137.7 as set forth in Ordering Paragraph 4 in Decision No. 72251 is hereby extended to July 1, 1970.

In all other respects, Decision No. 72251, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
