ORDER EXTENDING TIME

The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company and General Telephone Company of California requested in writing on October 31, 1969, an extension of the time limit within which to comply with the provisions of ordering paragraph 4 of Decision No. 75324 dated February 18, 1969.

Applicants based this request for extension of time on new facts developed as a result of two years' experience in offering directory service in the Southern Section of the Los Angeles extended area, which will make it possible to more closely meet the desires, needs and conveniences of the general public.

Applicants will report to this Commission on or prior to May 1, 1970, the results of such studies and discussions and will either file a new directory design proposal or if unsuccessful will proceed promptly to make the study ordered by Decision No. 75324. It appearing to the Commission that the time extension should be granted, therefore,
