ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By letter filed December 1, 1969, The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company seeks an extension of time within which to comply with that portion of Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision No. 74917 (issued November 6, 1968 in this matter) relating to COM PAK service associated with tariff schedule 22-T, Key Equipment Service, as described in Appendix A to said decision. Most conversions have been completed but access to certain locations, such as Lockheed, has been delayed. The company requests further extension to March 31, 1970 to endeavor to complete the required field modifications.

IT IS ORDERED that applicant is hereby granted an extension of time to and including March 31, 1970, in which to comply with

the aforesaid ordering paragraph as it pertains to COM PAK service.
