ORDER GRANTING PETITION FOR
 MODIFICATION OF DECISION NO. 74007

By Decision No. 74007, dated April 16, 1968, the Commission determined that it had jurisdiction over all the vehicular parking areas adjacent to Southern Pacific's railroad stations between San Jose and San Francisco. Among other requirements, Decision No. 74007 requires Southern Pacific to keep in operation all the parking spaces located in these parking lots and not to eliminate any of them without an appropriate order from the Commission.

By the petition herein Southern Pacific requests that Decision No. 74007 be modified to permit the elimination of eight parking stalls located in the parking lot at its San Bruno station. The stalls are at the northern end of the parking lot (See Exhibit A to the petition), and are being eliminated as the result of Southern Pacific's granting the City and County of San Francisco an easement for roadway purposes as shown on Exhibit A.

The staff has conducted a field investigation of the site and recommends that an ex parte decision be issued. Notice of the petition was published in the Commission's daily calendar on October 2, 1969. No protests have been filed.

After consideration the Commission concludes that the petition should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 74007 is modified to permit Southern Pacific Company to eliminate eight parking stalls in its parking lot adjacent to the San Bruno railroad station as shown in Exhibit A of the petition herein.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
