SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision No. 75512 dated April 1, 1969 authorized the State of California Department of Public Works, among other things, to relocate the Walnut Avenue crossing at grade across the tracks of the Southern Pacific Company approximately 200 feet southerly near Chino, San Bernardino County with protection to be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order 75-B) augmented with automatic gates.

Applicant has requested authority to open the relocated Walnut Avenue crossing to vehicular traffic prior to the scheduled installation of the automatic crossing protection (to prevent serious delays in the construction schedule of a large freeway bridge structure). Interim protection to be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs.

IT IS ORDERED that the State Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to open relocated Walnut Avenue (Crossing No. BAB-518.0) with interim protection by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective

sheet material. Train moves over the crossing shall be protected by a member of the train crew or other competent railroad employee acting as a flagman. This authority for interim protection shall expire within sixty days of the effective date of this order.

In all other respects, Decision No. 75512 shall remain in full force and effect.

Applicant has requested immediate authority in order to avoid delay in construction of a major freeway bridge structure. The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
