SECOND ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Applicant has requested an extension of time within which to exercise the authority granted in Decision No. 74231, alleging that it has been able to discontinue and abandon the existing station building and to construct a new passenger shelter but due to certain delays in negotiation and finalization of agreements that it has been unable to complete the relocated team track facilities. It is anticipated that the team track facilities will be completed by May 31, 1970.

IT IS ORDERED that the time limit within which applicant may exercise the authority granted in Decision No. 74231 is hereby, extended to May 31, 1970.

In all other respects the decision shall remain in full force and effect.
