OPINION AND ORDER

Arthur H. Burnett seeks an order requiring Solemint Water Company to make refunds for water main extension agreements covering Tracts Nos. 25927, 26122, 27335 and 27336 pursuant to Commission Tariff Rule and Regulation No. 15. The total amount of refunds claimed was not stated in the complaint.

On November 5, 1969, the defendant through its attorney, advised the Commission in writing (Exhibit No. 1) that, according to the records of the defendant, the sum of \$7,632.31 had accumulated on the 1968 refunds on the listed main extension contracts and that the said sum was due and payable on April 30, 1969. The defendant further advised that it will consent to the entry of an order directing it to pay to complainant such sum within 90 days after the effective date of said order, as 1968 refunds, plus interest thereon at 7 percent per annum from April 30, 1969, until paid.

On November 13, 1969, the complainant through his attorney, advised the Commission in writing (Exhibit No. 2) that the Commission may make an order in accordance with figures of the defendant.

In accordance with the advice of the parties,

IT IS ORDERED that Solemint Water Company pay to Arthur H. Burnett within 90 days after the effective date of this order, the sum of \$7,632.31, together with interest thereon at 7 percent per annum from April 30, 1969, until paid, said sum of \$7,632.31 representing the total amount of refunds due as of April 30, 1969, on main extension agreements for Tracts Nos. 25927, 26122, 27335 and 27336.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
