SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 76561, dated December 16, 1969, in this proceeding, Georgia-Pacific Corporation, doing business as The Paper Transport Company, was authorized to assess less than the minimum rates in connection with shipments of glass containers for Thatcher Glass Company. Inadvertently, a condition relating to extra charges when transportation is performed on holidays was omitted. Decision No. 76561 will be amended to add this provision.


IT IS ORDERED that Appendices A and B, attached to Decision No. 76561, are amended by adding the following condition:

A. 51432 ds

"2-1/2. Holidays. When transportation is performed on a holiday, there will be an additional charge of \$9.50 per hour."
