ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On December 9, 1969, hearing in the above entitled matter was held in San Bernardino before Examiner Robert Barnett. At that time the president of applicant moved to withdraw the application on the ground that conditions in the money market have so changed since the date of the application that applicant can no longer obtain the funds necessary to complete the proposed reorganization. He further stated that Golconda Utilities Company's petition for reorganization under Chapter X of the Bankruptcy Act will be withdrawn and a petition to be adjudicated bankrupt will be filed with the federal court forthwith.
