## ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATING AUTHORITY

2. Within thirty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than two days' notice to the Commission and to the public, Southern California Freight Forwarders shall amend its tariff presently on file with the Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.
