ORDER MODIFYING DECISION

Certain changes authorized in rates under the gas tariff schedules of Pacific Gas and Electric Company were not correctly translated in Appendix B from the development of the increase specified for Coalinga Nose on Page 23 of Decision No. 76655. This change and offsetting increases in the balance of the interruptible category will conform the rates to the same result set forth on Page 23 for the authorized level of revenues. Said Appendix should be revised in order to correct errors.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The rate of 33.60¢/Mcf shown on Page 5 of Appendix B for Excess Gas under Special Contract, Coalinga Nose Producers, is cancelled and replaced by a rate of 31.20¢/Mcf for said Excess Gas.
2. The rates for interruptible natural gas service under Schedules Nos. G-50, G-51 and G-53 for usage in excess of 100,000 therms per month as shown on Pages 5 and 6 on Appendix B are cancelled and replaced by the following:

G-51 Next 900,000 therms, per therm	4.098
Over 1,000,000 therms, per therm	3.746
G-53 Next 1,900,000 therms, per therm	3.746
Next 13,000,000 therms, per therm	3.293
Over 15,000,000 therms, per therm	3.202

The effective date of the revised rates shall be January 31, 1970, the date on which applicant's rates revised according to Appendix B as originally issued become effective.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
