ORDER

Southern Pacific Transportation Company is hereby authorized to construct a spur track at grade across McKinley Avenue near French Camp, San Joaquin County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. D-85.4-C. Construction of the crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the avenue now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with level grade of approach. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 3 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
