SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Lyles Trucking Company, Incorporated, a corporation, is a highway common carrier operating under a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by this Commission.

Donald Murchison, attorney for Lyles Trucking Company, Incorporated, has submitted to this Commission certified copies of a Certificate of Amendment of Articles of Incorporation filed with the Secretary of State changing its corporate name to "Sea-Air Container Transport, Inc." Accordingly, the certificate will be amended to show the new corporate name. The carrier will also be ordered to amend its tariffs pursuant to General Order No. 80-A. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Decision No. 72828 dated August 1, 1967, is amended by substituting "Sea-Air Container Transport, Inc." in place and stead of "Lyles Trucking Company, Incorporated."

2. Within one hundred and twenty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than thirty days' notice to the Commission and the public, Sea-Air Container Transport, Inc. shall amend its tariffs on file with this Commission as required by Rule 6.4 of General Order No. 80-A.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
