SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Speedy Transport, Incorporated, a corporation, is a high-way common carrier operating under a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by this Commission. Joseph D. Michael, attorney for Speedy Transport, Incorporated, has submitted to this Commission certified copies of Certificate of Amendment of Articles of Incorporation filed with the Secretary of State changing its corporate name to Campora Fast Freight, Inc. Accordingly the certificate will be amended to show the new corporate name. The carrier will also be ordered to amend its tariff pursuant to General Order No. 80-A. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Decision No. 61587 dated February 28, 1961, as amended by Decision No. 63663 dated May 8, 1962, and Decision No. 63664 dated May 8, 1962, is further amended by substituting "Campora Fast Freight, Inc." in place and stead of "Speedy Transport, Incorporated."

2. Within one hundred and twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than thirty days' notice to the Commission and the public, Campora Fast Freight, Inc., shall amend its tariffs on file with this Commission as required by Rule 6.4 of General Order No. 80-A.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
