In the matter of the application of SHIFFLET BROS., INC., a corporation, for authority to depart from minimum rates in connection with certain transportation to be performed for the Rice Growers Association of California.

ORIGINAL

OPINION AND ORDER

Shifflet Bros., Inc., a corporation, holds radial highway common carrier and highway contract carrier permits. It also possesses cement carrier authority for the transportation of cement to and within Butte and Sutter Counties from all points of origin. By Decision No. 75333 dated February 18, 1969, it was authorized to assess rates less than the applicable minimum rates for the transportation of paddy rice, in bulk, from various rice driers in the Sacramento Valley to the processing plant of Rice Growers Association of California at Biggs. The current authority is scheduled to expire with March 1, 1970. By this application authority is sought to continue the deviation from the established minimum rates for a further one year period. Applicant proposes that the rates be the same as presently authorized except that rates from three rice driers will be .5 cents higher than those presently authorized.

Applicant states that the conditions which justified the granting of the present authority still exist and that such rates are fully compensatory. Revenue and expense data furnished by applicant indicate that the transportation involved has been profitable and reasonably may be expected to be profitable during the ensuing year.

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The certificate of service shows that a copy of the application was mailed to California Trucking Association on January 5, 1970. The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of January 7, 1970. No objection to the granting of the application has been received.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the proposed rates are reasonable for the transportation involved. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the application should be granted.

In view of the impending expiration date of the current authority, the order which follows will be made effective March 1, 1970.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Shifflet Bros., Inc., a corporation, is hereby authorized to transport paddy rice, in bulk, for Rice Growers Association of California at rates less than the established minimum rates but not less than those set forth, and subject to the provisions specified, in Appendix A attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. The authority herein granted shall, on and after March 1, 1970 supersede the authority granted by Decision No. 75333 and shall expire with March 1, 1971.

Schedule of Minimum Rates for the transportation of paddy rice for Rice Growers Association of California

Section 1.

Item 10 - Application of Rates

The minimum rates and rules set forth in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 14-A are applicable on all shipments of paddy rice except as specifically provided in Section 2.

Section 2.

Item 20 - Application

Rates in this section are subject to a minimum weight of 48,000 pounds per shipment and apply only to the transportation of paddy rice, in bulk, from the points named in Item 30 to the plant of Rice Growers Association of California at Biggs.
