ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE  
AND  
TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

Upon reading of the verified complaint on file in this case, and the supporting verification, and it appearing to the Commission therefrom that this is a proper case for granting an order to show cause and temporary restraining order, and that unless an order to show cause and temporary restraining order is granted, plaintiff will suffer great and irreparable injury before the matter can be heard on motion; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the defendants Southern California Edison Company (Edison) and General Telephone Company of California (General) shall appear before Examiner John M. Gregory in the Commission Courtroom, 350 McAllister Street, San Francisco, California, 94102, at 10:00 a.m., on February 25, 1970, and then and there show cause why a cease and desist order should not be issued:

- (1) prohibiting both defendants from increasing pole attachment rates above \$3.00 per year;

- (2) directing Edison to continue to issue and service pole use agreements in accordance with its publicly announced offerings prior to July 30, 1969, at the rates in effect at that date; and
- (3) directing General to continue to issue and service pole use agreements in accordance with its letter to the Chairman of the Federal Communications Commission, dated December 1, 1969, at the rates in effect as of that date.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, pending the hearing on this order to show cause, the defendants are hereby restrained and ordered to cease and desist from engaging in, or performing the following acts:

- (1) increasing pole attachment rates above \$3.00 per year;
- (2) in the case of defendant Edison, from refusing to continue or to service pole use agreements in accordance with its publicly announced offerings prior to July 30, 1969 at the rates in effect as of that date;
- (3) in the case of defendant General, from refusing to issue or service pole use agreements in accordance with its letter to the Chairman of the Federal Communications Commission dated December 1, 1969, at the rates in effect at that time.

The Secretary is directed to cause a certified copy of this restraining order and order to show cause upon all defendants forthwith. Defendants shall file answers to the

complaint on or before the date of hearing, or within such time as may be designated by the Presiding Officer.
