ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

The certificate of public convenience and necessity acquired by James L. Bloch, doing business as Tri-City Delivery, was suspended until December 31, 1969, by Resolution No. 16352 dated December 17, 1968. It was suspended at the request of James L. Bloch who informed the Commission by letter that the major portion of the business conducted pursuant to the certificate had been lost or diverted.

On January 8, 1970, James L. Bloch informed the Commission by letter that the certificate is no longer necessary and requested that the operative right be revoked.

In the circumstances, it appears and the Commission finds that revocation of the certificate of public convenience and necessity as requested would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

The Commission concludes that the certificate should be revoked and that the tariffs applicable to the services thereunder should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier granted to James L. Bloch, doing business as Tri-City Delivery, by Decision No. 62396, dated August 8, 1961 in Application No. 43158, is hereby revoked.

2. Leland C. Smith, Agent, is hereby authorized and directed to cancel the participation of James L. Bloch, doing business as Tri-City Delivery, from the tariffs issued by Pacific Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., such cancellations to be made within ninety days after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

3. The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon James L. Bloch, doing business as Tri-City Delivery, or mail a certified copy thereof to him at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records and to mail a copy of this order to Leland C. Smith, Agent.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
