ORDER OF DISMISSAL

In the above entitled application Pacific Lighting Service Company states that the authorizations it seeks therein are necessary only in the event that the Cost of Service Tariff applied for in an earlier application has not been authorized. By Decision No. 76598 dated December 23, 1969 in Application No. 50715, Pacific Lighting Service Company was authorized to file revised tariff Schedule No. G-62, Cost of Service Tariff for Resale Natural Gas

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Service and the filing of said schedule was made on December 30, 1969.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 51569 is dismissed.
