OPINION AND ORDER

Items 320 and 320-1 of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 contain descriptions of various canned goods and exception ratings for the transportation of such commodities. It has come to the Commission's attention that, through inadvertence, the listing for syrups in Item 320-1 of the tariff does not include certain coloring syrups.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the necessary correction should be made by the order herein. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 should be amended accordingly.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 (Appendix "D" to Decision No. 31606, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective March 28, 1970, Eleventh Revised Page 31 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. Tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not

earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff page incorporated in this order.

3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the ratings authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the ratings published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

4. In all other respects Decision No. 31606, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty-four days after the date hereof.
