ORDER


The San Francisco Bay Area Rapid Transit District is hereby authorized to construct a pedestrian undercrossing of the main line tracks of the Southern Pacific Transportation Company at Nevin Avenue between 16th and 18th Streets in the City of Richmond, Contra Costa County, at the location and substantially as shown by plans, Exhibit B, attached to the application to be identified as Crossing No. A-15.0-BD.

Construction and maintenance expense of the pedestrian undercrossing shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties thereto, and a copy of said agreement, together with plans of said undercrossing, approved by the Southern Pacific Transportation Company shall be filed with the Commission within 130 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless

time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
