## O R D E R

The City of Santa Clara is hereby authorized to construct Bowers Avenue at grade across a track of Southern Pacific Transportation Company in Santa Clara, Santa Clara County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. E-41.9-C.

Width of crossing shall be not less than 64 feet and grades of approach not greater than one percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by four Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) augmented with automatic gate arms.

Applicant shall bear entire expense of construction (and installation of automatic protection, also maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Transportation Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines. Maintenance costs of the automatic protection shall be borne by the applicant, pursuant to the provisions of Section 1202.2 of the Public Utilities Code.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years
