SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 75892 dated July 8, 1969 the operating authority of Lads Furniture Freight, Inc. was amended so as to provide for its transportation of new household, office and store furniture and fixtures and appliances whether crated or uncrated. By Decision No. 76332 dated October 28, 1969 the order was amended by a finding that public convenience and necessity require applicant's service to the same extent on shipments moving in interstate commerce. Further amendment of the order is requested to comply with a requirement of the Interstate Commerce Commission that there be a concurrent finding of public convenience and necessity relating to intrastate, interstate and foreign commerce. An appropriate notice was published in the Federal Register on September 10, 1969. No protest has been received.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The opinion portion of Decision No. 75892 dated July 8, 1969 and as amended by Decision No. 76332 dated October 28, 1969 is hereby further amended by incorporating therein the following finding:

"Public convenience and necessity require applicant's service for the transportation of shipments of new household, office and store furniture and fixtures, and new household, office and store appliances moving in intrastate, interstate and foreign commerce between the points as set forth in Appendix A of Decision No. 61029."

2. The time within which to comply with the provisions of Decision No. 75892 is hereby extended to July 1, 1970.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
