O R D E R

City of Oakland is hereby authorized to widen the crossing at separated grades of Seventh Street under the tracks of Southern Pacific Transportation Company in Oakland, Alameda County, at the location and substantially as shown by plans attached to the application, identified as Crossing No. A-4.7-B.

An agreement has been entered into between the parties relative to construction and maintenance expense, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by the Southern Pacific Transportation Company, shall be filed with the Commission within one hundred eighty days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-D.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
