ORDER EXTENDING TIME AND
REOPENING FOR FURTHER HEARING

The City of Los Angeles by Decision No. 75313, issued February 11, 1969, in the above entitled matter, was authorized to construct a pedestrian crossing at grade at Slauson Avenue over the tracks of the Southern Pacific Company.

The Commission now is advised in writing that the city and railroad are not in agreement with respect to the construction plans of the authorized crossing.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the time to comply with Decision No. 75313 is extended to March 3, 1971, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Application No. 50605 is reopened for further hearing respecting the plan of construction of the crossing authorized, said further hearing to be held before Examiner Rogers at such time and place as the Commission may designate hereafter.
