SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The State of California Department of Public Works, by Decision No. 75398 was authorized to construct Oak Knoll Avenue at grade across a track of Southern Pacific Transportation Company, Crossing No. AB-74.3, and to close four existing private grade crossings in connection with construction of State Route 29 near Napa, Napa County.

The State of California Department of Public Works has filed a petition to modify Decision No. 75398 to authorize the additional closure of the Orchard Avenue Crossing No. AB-73.3. In order to close the Orchard Avenue crossing a frontage road will be provided between Orchard Avenue and Locust Avenue.

IT IS ORDERED that Lines one and two on Page two of Decision No. 75398 which reads:

"Upon completion, the existing private crossings located at Mileposts 74.13, 74.55, 74.69 and 75.14 shall be abandoned and closed".

be changed to read:

Upon completion, the existing private crossings located at Mileposts 74.13, 74.55, 74.69 and 75.14 and the existing public crossing of Orchard Avenue, No. AB-73.2, shall be abandoned and closed.

In all other respects Decision No. 75398 shall remain in full force and effect.
