Application of City of Rocklin
to Public Utilities CommissionApplication No. 51469
(Filed November 7, 1969)ORDER

City of Rocklin is hereby authorized to construct Laurel Street at grade across a spur track of Southern Pacific Transportation Company in the City of Rocklin, Placer County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. AI-110.9-C.

Width of crossing shall be not less than forty feet and grade of approach not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 3 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Applicant shall bear entire expense of construction and installation of automatic protection, also maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Transportation Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines. Maintenance costs of the automatic protection shall be borne by the applicant, pursuant to the provisions of Section 1202.2 of the Public Utilities Code.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing.

This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
