ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

The certificate of public convenience and necessity acquired by Hecht Fast Freight, Inc. (Hecht) has been suspended since April 24, 1969, for failure on the part of the carrier to have on file with the Commission the required classification and C.O.D. bond. Hecht amended its tariff effective June 5, 1969, to provide that it will not accept C.O.D. shipments thereby eliminating the necessity for having a C.O.D. bond on file with the Commission. However, the carrier has not filed the required classification to date.

Hecht not having the required classification on file, the Commission finds that such failure constitutes good cause for revocation of the certificate and cancellation of the tariff applicable to the services thereunder.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier acquired by Hecht Fast Freight, Inc., by Decision No. 63371 dated March 6, 1962, as amended by Decision No. 74610 dated August 27, 1968, in Application No. 43995, is hereby revoked.

2. Local Freight Tariff No. 1, Cal.P.U.C. 2 (Series of California Pool Car Distributors, Inc.) is hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Hecht Fast Freight, Inc., or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's record.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof.
